- 5. Member Drive (follow up to goal of hitting 100 members & amp; increased social media followers)
  - Does membership want the chamber to have a membership drive?
    - Membership Drive Concept
      Goals: 1) increase membership and active engagement with chamber social media; 2) incentivize joining to new businesses while being fair to current members.
    - Create a Member Drive to take place for 2 months (I.e. May to June), during which startup businesses (in operation for 2 years or less without a controlling affiliation by a corporate enterprise, I.e. a franchise) will be eligible to receive one-time their first year of chamber membership at the non-profit price level of \$50.00. The incentive pricing will cease to apply after June 30 and would not apply if the prospect does not meet the eligibility conditions.

Other ideas -

- Some kind of token gift for current members that make successful referrals.
- Token gift to businesses joining during the drive that do not get incentive pricing.
- Don't give incentive pricing, but offer something different during the member drive (chamber bucks, gift card to a chamber member business, etc.)
- Require pick up or collection of member drive benefit at an in-person event (regular meeting or Business After Hours)
- Take out ad space in DCI and feature businesses joining during the drive.
