Dr. Dave Thompson shared the following: The Kasson-Mantorville School District (KMSD) reviewed, adjusted, and restructured the remaining \$39.8 million bond debt, resulting in substantial savings of nearly \$1.5 million. Taxpayers in the district will experience reduced property tax bills, and the savings generated will be distributed over the remaining lifespan of the debt, which extends until February 2037.
 - b. Activities Update: Dodge County Wildcats Girls Hockey team was the state runner-up. Boys wrestling also performed at the state level for both the team and individuals. Our Knowledge Bowl, Robotics, and Speech Team are also going to state.
 - c. Dr. Dave Thompson introduced the newly hired superintendent, Ted Ihns. Mr. Ihns begins his role on July 1, 2024.
